

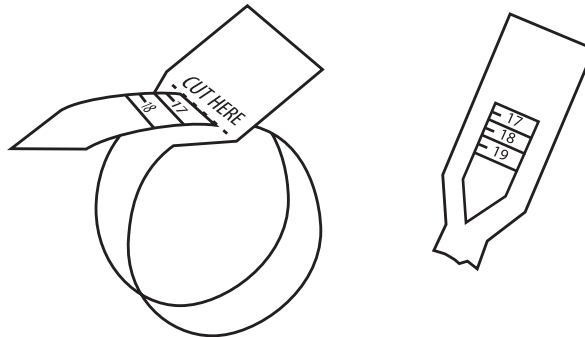


## Ring sizer

Your printable ring sizer from kreitto.  
Choose from the three accurate measuring techniques.

### Paper method

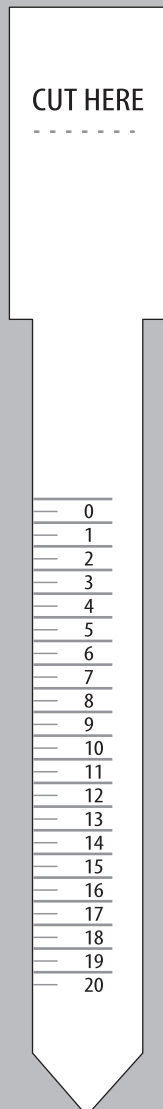
- Print and carefully cut out our paper ring sizer on the left.
- Create a slit by making a small cut indicated with dashed line (CUT HERE).
- Slip the arrow end through the slit creating a circle.
- MEASURE: Place around your finger and pull the arrow end to create a snug fit.
- DETERMINE: The number line located at the "CUT HERE" slit, is the proper ring size.
- TIP: Be careful not to wrap the paper too tight. Aim for a comfortable, snug fit.
- TIP: For the most accurate measure, have someone help you measure.
- TIP: Double check to be sure.

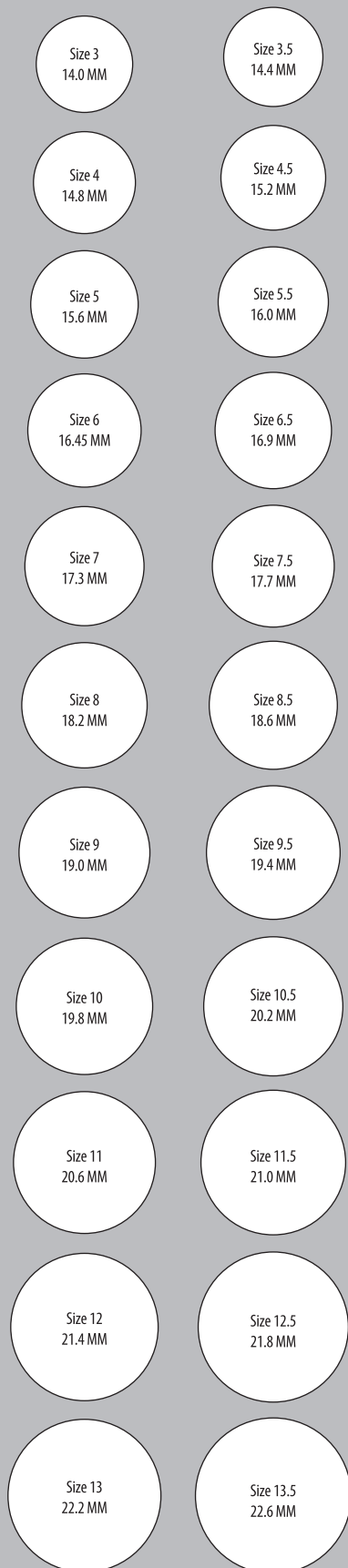


### String method

- Cut a small piece of string, thread or ribbon.
- TIP: Make sure the string, thread or ribbon is NOT elastic.
- MEASURE: Wrap it around your finger for an accurate measurement.
- TIP: Be careful not to wrap it up too tight. Aim for a comfortable, snug fit.
- DETERMINE: Compare your measurement with the chart on the left.
- TIP: For the most accurate measure, have someone help you measure.
- TIP: Double check to be sure.

## Double checking method

- Print out the chart of ring size circles on the left.
- Find a ring that you love.
- Make sure that the ring you are about to purchase is for the same finger.
- **MEASURE:** Place the ring on top of each circle until you find a perfect match.
- **DETERMINE:** The match should perfectly fit the **INSIDE** on the ring.
- **TIP:** Double check to be sure.
